FIGURE 1: INDIVIDUAL LICENSES AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012

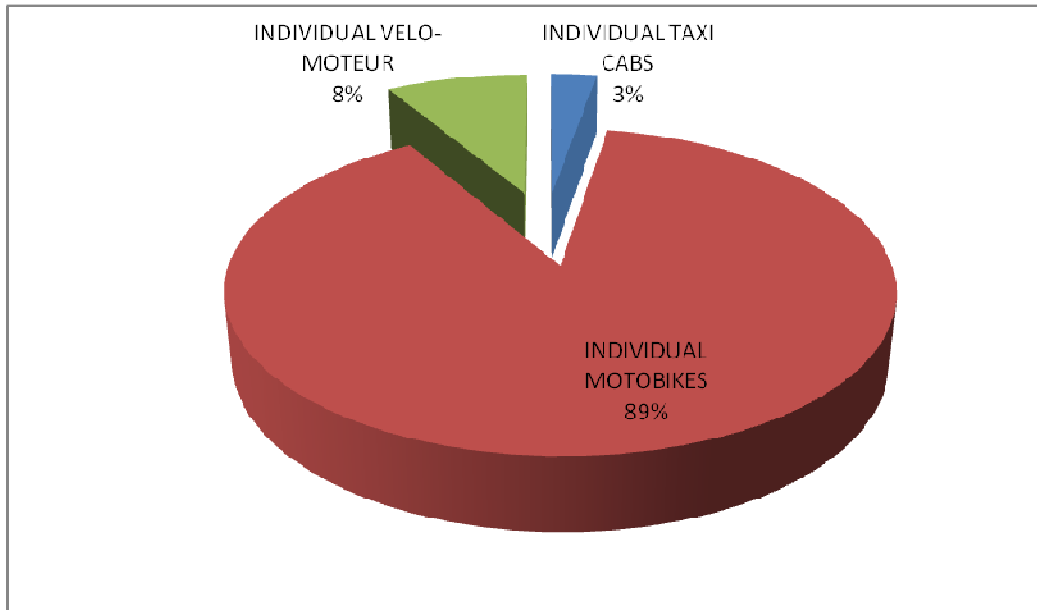
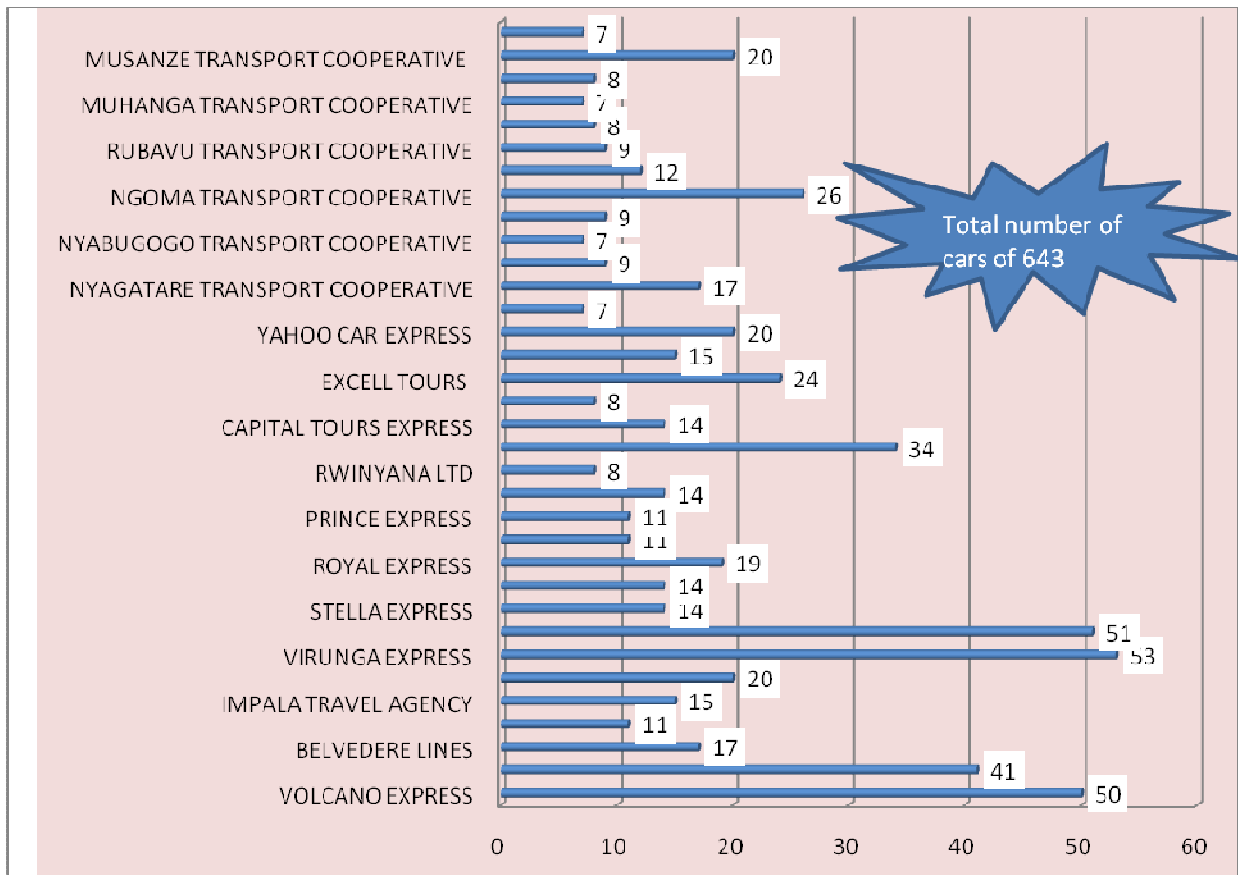
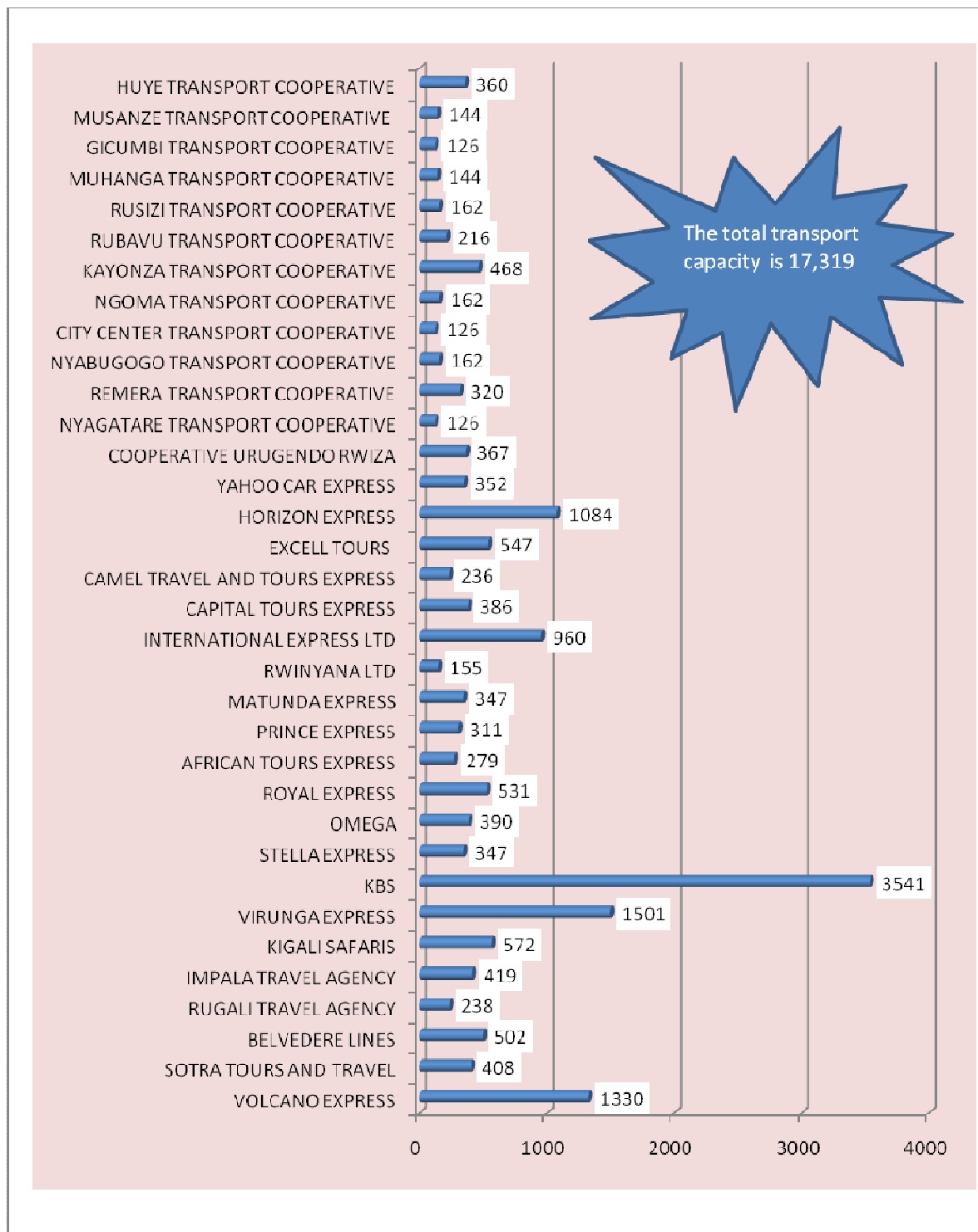


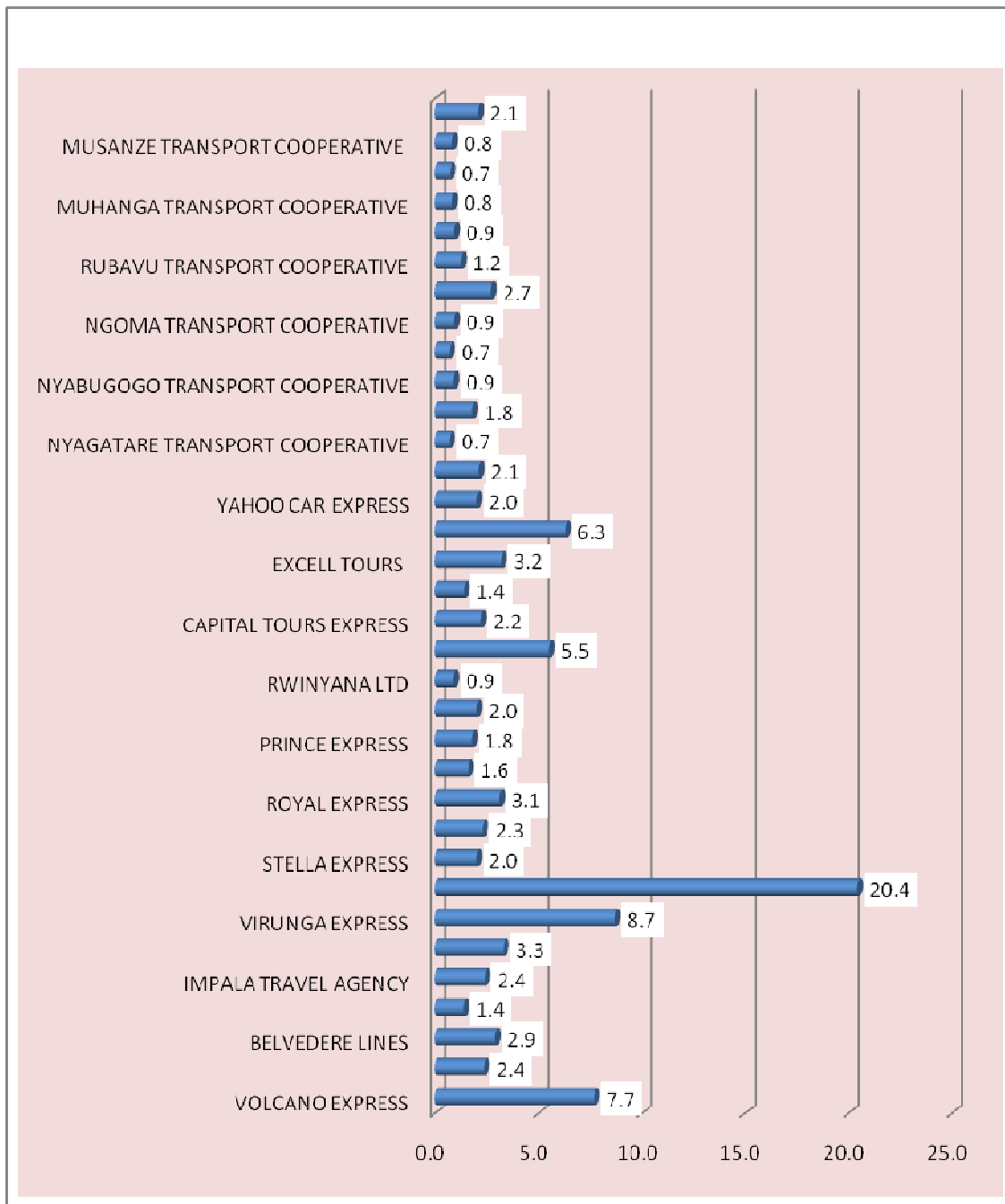
FIGURE 2: NUMBER OF CARS USED BY TRANSPORT COMPANIES

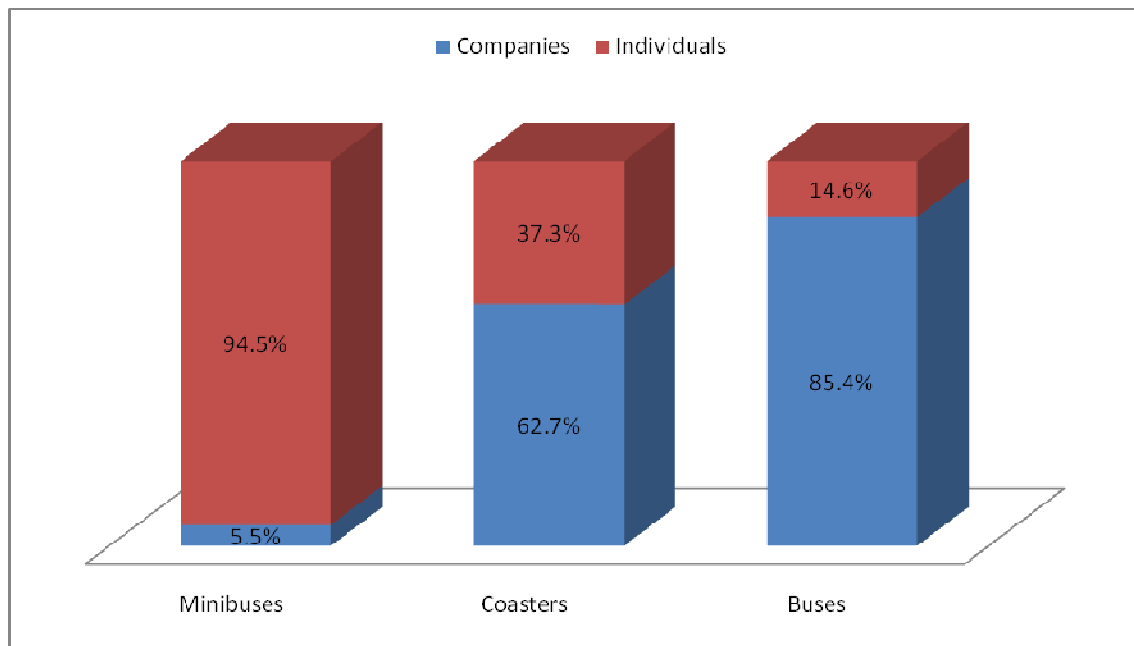


**FIGURE 4: % CAPACITY MARKET SHARE BY NATIONAL TRANSPORT COMPANIES IN THE TRANSPORT OF PERSONS AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012**

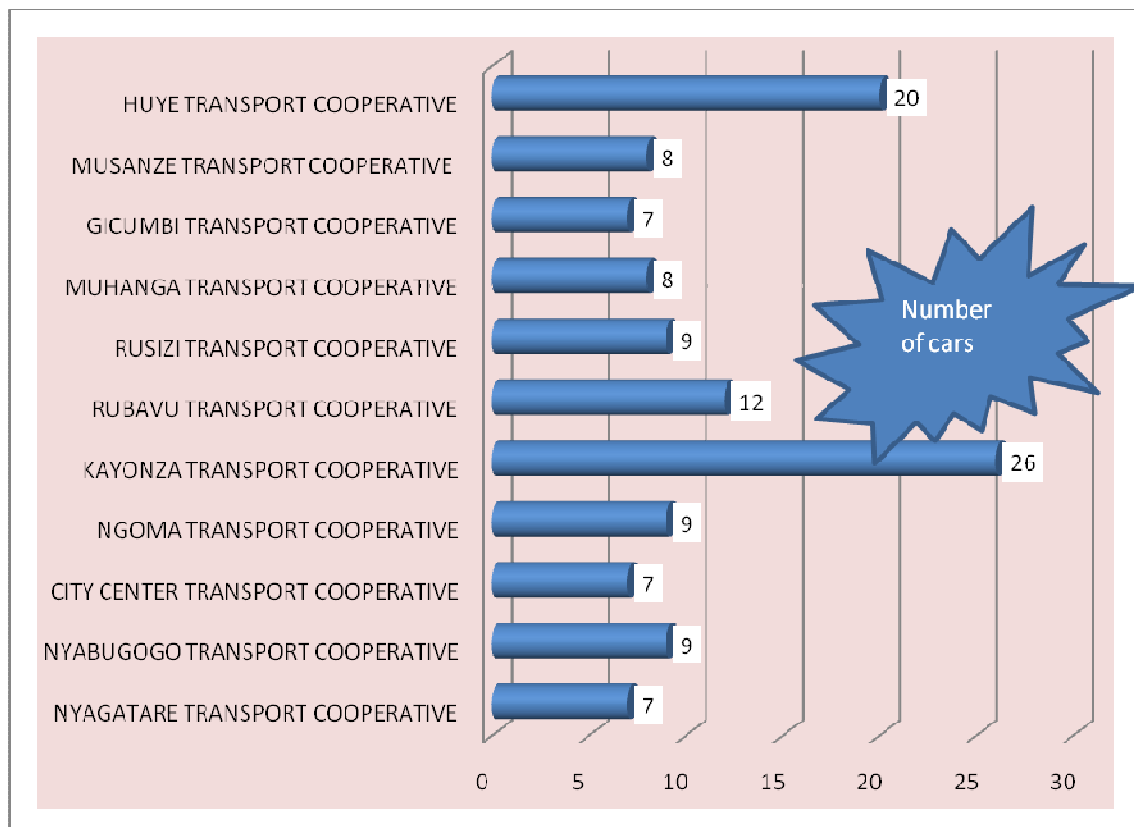


KBS is the first with high capacity of 13.5% market share followed by Virunga that has 10.4% market share.

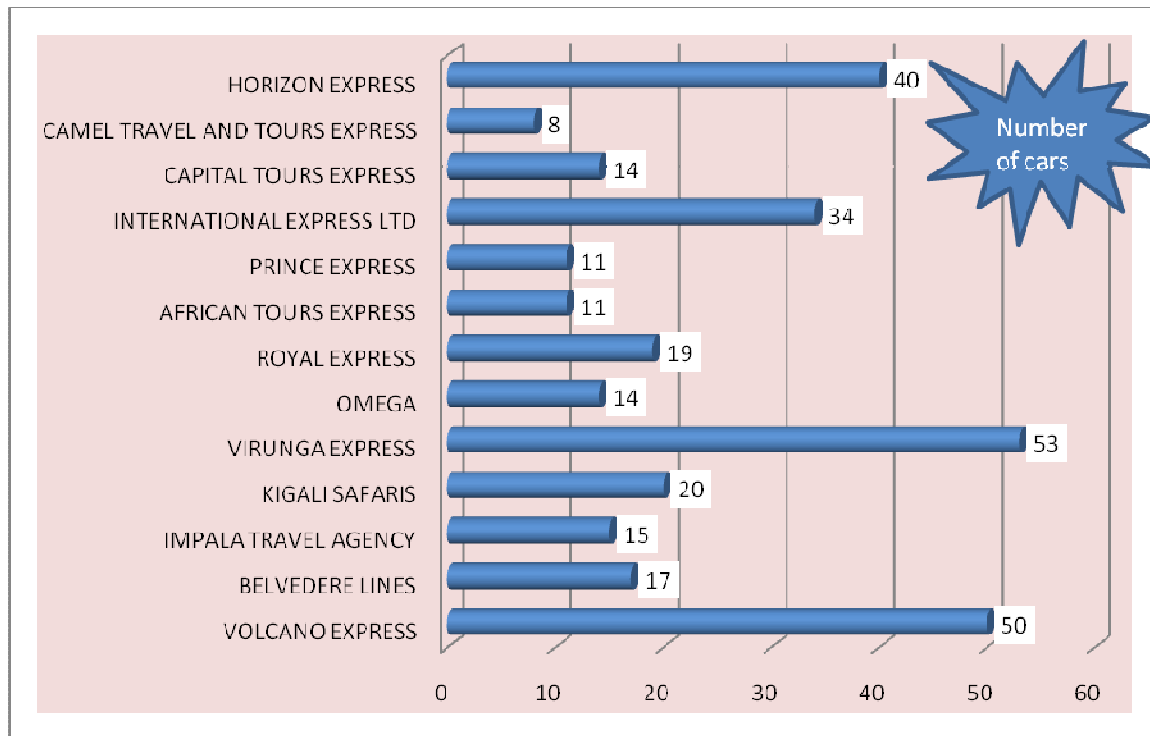


**FIGURE 6: TRANSPORT COMPANIES THAT USE MINIBUSES ONLY AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012**

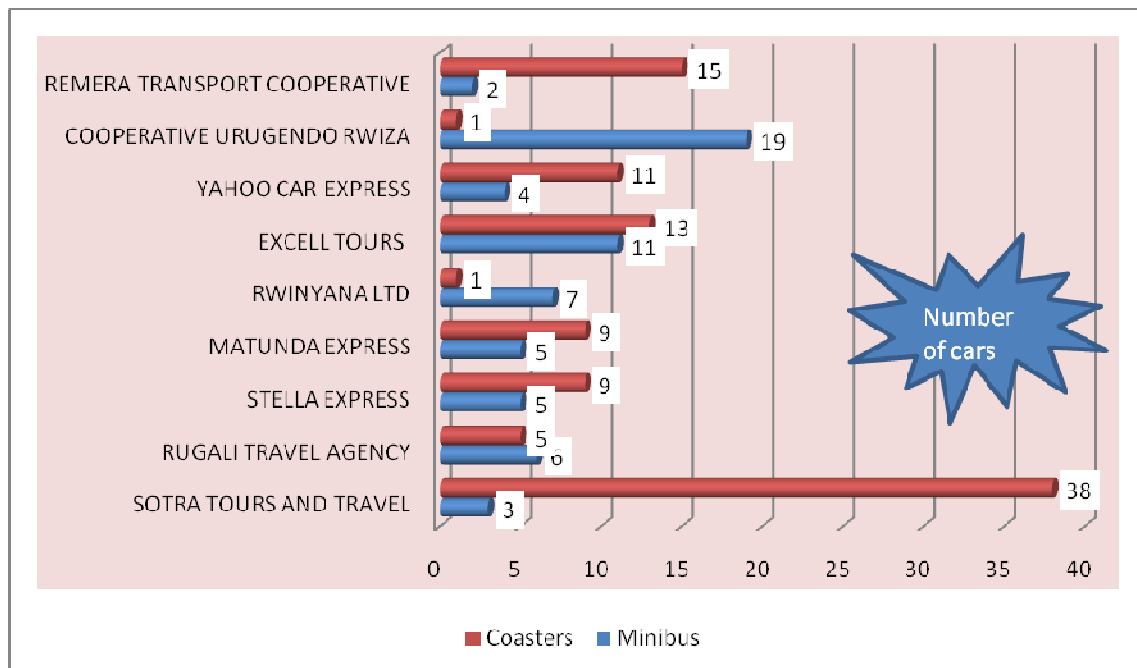




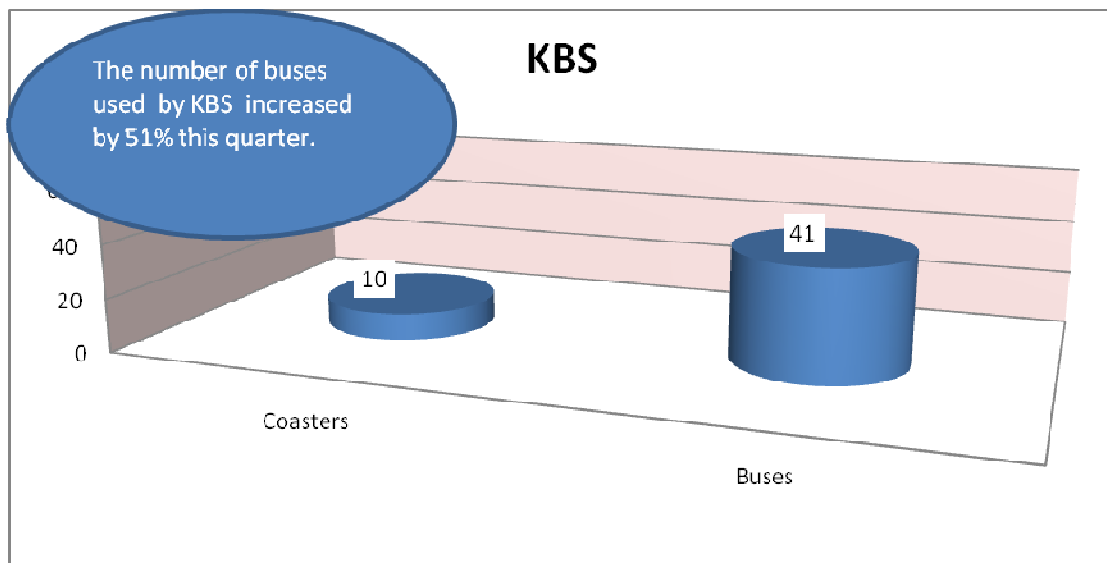
**FIGURE 7: TRANSPORT COMPANIES THAT USE COASTERS ONLY AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012**

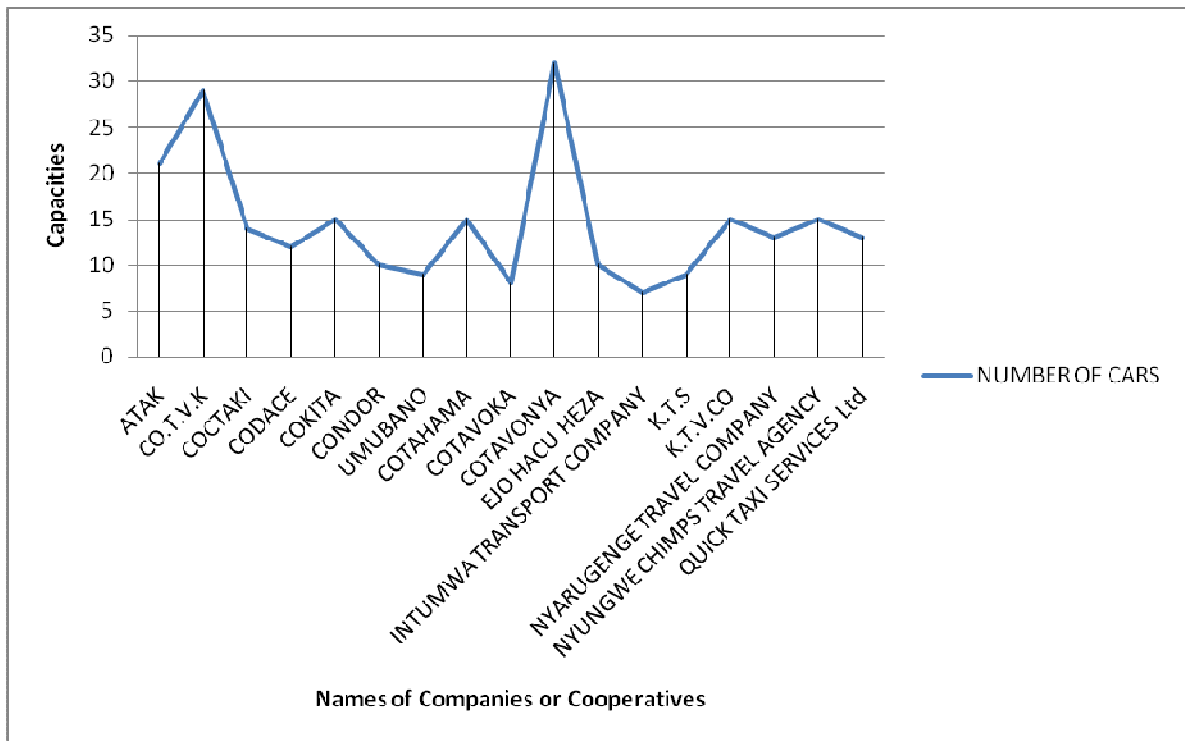


FIGURE 10: TREND IN INDIVIDUAL LICENSES AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012
