

# MOBILE-CELLULAR TELEPHONE SUBSCRIPTIONS REPORT AS OF JUNE 2023

## 1. Mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions as of June 2023


The number of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions<sup>1</sup> in Rwanda increased from 11,549,143 as of May 2023 up to 11,714,982 SIM cards recorded at the end of June 2023, representing an increase of 1.44%. The postpaid subscriptions increased from 168,243 as of May 2023 to 169,697 SIM cards as of June 2023 and the prepaid subscriptions increased up to 11,545,285 as of June 2023 in comparison to 11,380,900 SIM cards published at the end of May 2023. The Table 1 illustrates the number of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per Mobile Network Operator.





Figure 2: Trend of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions by postpaid and prepaid



### 2. Mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants

As of June 2023, the Mobile Penetration Rate that refers to the number of active SIM cards per total projected population have upraised to 87.4% in comparison to 86.4% for May 2023 publications.

#### 3. Market share for mobile (SIM cards) subscriptions




Figure 4: Market share trends for mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per operator

As of June 2023, the mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions market shares for MTN Rwanda Ltd reduced by 0.7 percentage points to 61.9% whereas that for AIRTEL Rwanda Ltd upraised by the same margin reaching 38.1% in comparison to May 2023 statistics as displayed by the Figure 4.
